The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics projects total aviation technician employment is expected to exceed 139,000 by 2031.<sup>2</sup> Planes keep our world moving, and the transportation industry relies on individuals with the right skills and experience to ensure aircraft are operating properly.

The Airframe & Powerplant Technician training program covers skills that technicians use in the field. Graduates are also eligible to apply and test for Airframe and Powerplant FAA certification.<sup>3</sup>
